

Learn how to view and manage your notifications to minimize disruption to your work throughout the day. You can see your latest notifications on the lock screen when you pick up your iPhone or wake up your iPad. You can also do the following on the lock screen: Tap an individual notification to open the app it came from. Tap a notification group to view all recent notifications from that app. You can manage notifications for this app or remove notifications by swiping left on a notification. Touch and hold notifications to view notifications and take quick actions when the app prompts them. To display notification content on the lock screen without unlocking your device, go to Settings > Notifications > Show Preview and choose Always. Notification Center shows your notification history so you can go back and see what you've missed. You can view Notification Center notifications in two ways: On the lock screen, swipe up from the middle of the screen. On any other screen, swipe down from the center at the top of the screen. To clear your notification history, click the Close button, then click Clear. Manage notifications from the lock screen or from the notification center. Swipe left on a notification or notification group. Tap Options and select one of the following options: Mute for 1 hour Mute for today Display settings Disable You can also tap Display settings to change notification styles or notification settings for a particular app. Requires an iPhone with iOS 16 or later. Go to Settings > Notifications. In the "Show as" section, choose how notifications are displayed on the lock screen: Count: Displays the total number of notifications at the bottom of the screen. Touch the number to view the notification. Stacks: Shows notifications grouped at the bottom of the screen, with the most recent notification at the top. List: Displays notifications as a list. In iOS 15 and iPadOS 15 or later, you can schedule a time to receive a notification summary each day, so you can catch up when it suits you. The summary is customized for you and prioritized based on how you use the app, with the most relevant notifications at the top. To schedule a notification summary: Go to Settings > Notifications > Scheduled Summary and turn on Scheduled Summary. In the App Summary section, select the apps you want to include in the notification summary. In the Schedule section, click Add to add a new schedule or Delete to remove a schedule. Then adjust the time for each scheduled summary you set up. To add new apps to your summary, go back to Settings > Notifications > Scheduled review and select apps under App Summary. Each app is listed with a number representing the average number of notifications received from that app each day. Go to "Settings" and tap on "Notifications". Under Notification style, select an app. Under Notifications, select the appropriate notification style. If you enable Enable Notifications, choose when the notifications should be delivered - immediately or in a summary of scheduled notifications. With iOS 15 and iPadOS 15 or later, you can turn on critical notifications for supported apps, so you'll receive notifications even when your iPhone is on silent or when you're in Focus. Go to "Settings" and tap on "Notifications". Select an app and tap Notification Grouping. Choose from the following options: Automatic: App notifications are grouped by organizational criteria within the app, such as B. by topic or thread. By App: All app notifications are grouped together. Off: Disables grouping. Go to Settings and tap Notifications, then tap Siri Suggestions. Close all applications. Go to Settings > Notifications and select an app. Tap Show preview and select an option. Some apps use your location to send you relevant notifications based on your location. For example, you can be reminded to call someone when you arrive at a certain location or when you leave for the next location. If you do not want to receive these types of notifications, you can turn them off. Go to Settings > Privacy & security > Location services, then tap the app to turn notifications based on your location on or off. Learn more about location services. The lock screen on your Android phone can be very useful as it displays notifications and allows you to access certain features without unlocking the phone first. (Something that might be even more helpful if you have a Pixel 6 or 6 Pro and still have problems with the fingerprint sensor.) Here are a few ways to adjust your lock screen settings. These were tested on a Pixel 6 running Android 12; As always, different Android phones may have slightly different procedures. Turn on notifications on the lock screen First, you can choose to show both notifications and silent notifications, only notifications, or no notifications at all. Open your phone's settings (usually by swiping down from the top and tapping the gear icon) and select Notifications. Scroll down and tap Silent notifications on lock screen; hide silent conversations and notifications (silent notifications are those that appear without sound or vibration, such as the weather or headline); or not show notifications at all. (Again, your mileage and exactly what it shows may vary depending on the manufacturer of your phone and the version of Android you're running.) To enable this feature, select Notifications from the lock screen. There are three options for how (or if) you want notifications to appear on the lock screen. You can also choose whether to show sensitive information on the lock screen by turning sensitive notifications on or off. If it's off, you'll only see the app that sent the notification, not the notification itself. For example, you'll see "1 new message" instead of message details. Choose which apps appear on the lock screen. The apps that appear on the lock screen are the same apps that are allowed to send you notifications. You can choose which one. Go to phone settings. Select Notifications > App Settings. You will see a list of your applications; You can sort them alphabetically by newest or most common; You can also list which apps are disabled. Use the switch to the right of each app's name to enable or disable its notifications entirely. If you click on an app name, you can manage more specific notification types for that app. You can organize apps that send notifications in different ways. You can refine notifications for each app. Getting personal information on the lock screen While you can only receive general notifications on the lock screen, such as news headlines or the weather forecast, you can also receive more personal notifications about emails, reminders, flight reservations, and other items. When your phone is on, tell Google Assistant to open Assistant settings. You can also find them under Settings > Apps > Assistant > See all Assistant settings > Personal results. On the Your Phone tab, make sure Personal Results is turned on (so Assistant can access your email, calendar, etc.). You can then enable personal suggestions on the lock screen before asking a question. He can toa bit annoying when you accidentally start it so it suddenly starts talking. Here's how you can enable or disable the Google Assistant on the lock screen. Go back to Settings > Apps > Assistant > View all Assistant settings, but this time select Lock Screen Switch to Assistant's responses on the lock screen. Now when you say "Hey Google", your phone will respond. If you want to activate the Google Assistant from the lock screen without saying anything (for example, simply touching the screen), skip to the second section of this page. This time, on the Assistant settings page, select Lock screen. You can enable assistant reply lock screen; below you can get the results by tapping the screen. According to Google, there are certain voice responses that won't come from the lock screen, even if you allow personal results to be displayed. These include payments, Google Photos services, requests to open other apps, or questions about your name or address.
