

Go ahead and place the topics between blocks and remove the pins. And yes, you will notice that I do not make my pins, but we sewed on them. And again, just worry about softening your sewing patch before staying under the pair. I like to start by the first finger by pressing the seam toward the pie pieces. I do not use a roll or anything, just press enough so you are not trying to turn to the crust sake. Now, before we started sewing to breathe deep :) The most relaxed you are, the most easy curves are sewing. And your block is prisoner and ready to sew. Step 4 - Sewing a modified bend path unit and now you are ready to sew. Then adjust your finger pulling to pull up and rotate your iron point to the side. Once you have your pieces cut, regardless of the square of the size you cut them, just combine the pieces of pie background with the pieces of print and the pieces of print pie With the background crust pieces, as shown. Then you are ready to start tailoring curves !! Cutting the curve takes a small practice to get used to, but just relax and you will get it. It's really fast when you get the hang of the way and you will not have to raise your iron or let go with the other hand, it's just changing the way are pulling you as you go. Just keep focused on what you're about to go under the foot. We enjoyed you reading our newsletter! It has been a week full of our favorite fabric types - strawberries and flowers! Once your templates are cut, check them back to the pattern to make sure they do not need to be trimmed in any area. Step 2 - Cut now you have your templates ready and you are ready to start cutting your bbbbed path units. Really, make sure and use the point of your iron to press this stitching and keep it nice and flat. Relax and let your cutter slide along the edge. Now just try to imagine that it is how to sew straight lines just a little more aligning how you go. We used the beautiful collection bittersweetA e by Sue Daley designs. Some people use 1 and some people use a ton :) If you think you want more than 3 pins, fabulous, if you find you like 1, wonderful !! Make what works best for you :) Okay, to start, we need to find the center of our pieces, then to do this, bend your pie and crust in half and finger tighten the crease. It does not matter if you are using a print pie or bottom pie, as long as the crust is the opposite. Now with the rights sides together, put the crust on the pie aligning the two creases. But once you feel confident, it will save a lot of time. Just keep aligning with the right hand and smoothing with the left hand. , Nova, it is not necessary. I just like the idea of holding this sewing in place.) Now, I just passed this super fast, and I know, it can be difficult to say the photos, but Remember, slow and stable and try to relax. It is a great moment to put in a movie or hear a great book, or or A chat with a friend on the phone. Pin Up as you like !! So you can chain your blocks. To do this, just keep feeding them through your machine one after the other. Once your blocks are all sewn. You will always be pressing for pie pieces. A, holding the model in place, gently cuts along the internal curve of the model, gently is the key here. You will need to cut a little to start and finish that you have no model guide, but just keep it straight and aligned with your model. Then slide the pie now looking out of the way and then cut along the top and bottom of the model to cut the excess fabric. Click on the image to be taken to your favorite package!
